Farm News

Season six at Edwin Binney's Community Farm and Education Centre is well underway. This year we launched volunteer Wednesdays, a volunteer session from 4 to 7pm. Kawartha Lakes summer day camps are returning weekly for programming, and we have other pop-up programs like children's story time with the library and farm camp with Pinnguaq. We also had an accessible pathway installed through the farm so all people can enjoy our workshops and volunteering.

We have another group of enthusiastic and hard working students working with us this season. Without them we could not make the farm the success it is.

To date, over 9,000 pounds of fresh produce with a value of \$25,200 have been donated to food banks and food programs in Kawartha Lakes and Haliburton County.

In July we launched a partnership with Boshkung Brewing Company out of Minden. Funded Program spotlight: Through our Community Capacity grant we funded BGC Kawarthas' efforts to improve food security for youth and families using their centre and provide them with supports to help meet their basic needs. This took the form of two little pantries stocked with food and hygiene items and having a Youth Outreach worker to be present during afteer school programs to engage youth and connect them with supports to meet their needs.

"As I approached the pantry with groceries, I saw a woman with a bag. I thought she was looking for items on the empty shelves, but she in fact brought some food to put into the pantry. I spoke to the woman and she shared that she has taken food from the pantry when she needs it, but that today she could give. She thanked me for adding food to the pantry as well. She left her plastic bag in the pantry for the next person who needed it and left empty handed. It was an impactful moment that showed me just how much people care." – Support Worker, BGC Kawarthas
