- We provide fresh produce to 30 food banks and organizations with food security programs in Kawartha Lakes and Haliburton County
- 84,703 pounds of produce donated since 2019.
- 2,398 individuals served through food distribution programs annually.
- An average of \$50,000 of food is given out for free to 13 community food programs run through social service agencies annually - equal to approximately 4,500 meals each season.
- Over 700 kids and youth attend the farm for educational programming annually.
